COMPULSORY CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION AND PRACTICING CERTIFICATE RENEWAL FOR REGISTERED TCM PRACTITIONERS (FULL REGISTRATION)

The Continuing TCM Education programme was introduced by MOH and TCM Practitioners Board as a voluntary scheme in 2013 to encourage the continual upgrading of professional knowledge of registered TCM practitioners in Singapore. Following the passing of the TCM Practitioners (Amendment) Bill in Parliament on 11 Feb 2019, all registered TCM practitioners will be required to fulfil the prescribed Continuing Professional Education (CPE) requirements for the renewal of Practicing Certificates (PCs). Compulsory CPE will be implemented with effect from 1 Apr 2020.

- TCM practitioners on full registration will be required to accumulate 50 CPE points within 2 years starting from 1 Apr 2020, to renew PC every 2 years. For the first round, TCM practitioners will have till 31 Mar 2022 to accumulate the 50 CPE points before they could renew PC in 2022. Out of the 50 CPE points, at least 30 CPE points (60%) must be from accredited courses on traditional Chinese medicine practice and 20 points can be from relevant approved topics.
- To encourage TCM practitioners to upgrade themselves using different platforms, we have expanded the types of training activities for TCM practitioners to attend. These include case study discussions, clinical mentorship training and online self-study programmes. Please refer to Annex A for the different categories of CPE activities and the points awarded.
- 4 MOH and TCMP Board have put in place the following measures to support TCM practitioners in fulfilling the CPE requirements:
 - a) A list of accredited CPE training courses/events is made available at the Board's website, www.tcmpb.gov.sg for reference.
 - b) An enhanced CPE system will be launched from this year to allow TCM practitioners to check and monitor their CPE points through the Board's website.
 - c) TCM practitioners may tap on the TCM Development Grant, capped at \$200 per year to defray the costs of attending CPE courses. For more information on the TCM Development Grant, please visit MOH website, www.moh.gov.sg or contact MOH TCMDG Secretariat at Tel: 6325 1564/ 6325 1253/ 6325 3426.

Alignment of PC

5 TCM practitioners on full registration whose PCs are expiring on 30 Jun 2019 will have their PC renewed for 1 year until 30 Jun 2020 before moving on to a 2-year PC renewal cycle. This is to align all PCs to the same expiry date.
