IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PHARMACISTS ON CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

- 1. If the conditionally registered pharmacist leaves the employment of the training centre, the following will be cancelled:
 - a. Conditional registration
 - b. Practising certificate
- 2. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration within 2 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she needs to complete the balance of the duration of conditional registration.
 - b. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.
- 3. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration after 2 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she will have to re-start the full duration of 1 year / 2 years* conditional registration.
 - b. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.
- 4. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration after 5 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she will have to sit and pass the Competency Exam and Forensic Exam first.
 - b. Exam fees apply
 - c. If both exams are cleared, he/she can apply to re-start the full duration of 1 year / 2 years* conditional registration.
 - d. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.
