IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PRE-REGISTRATION PHARMACISTS

A. PRE-REGISTRATION TRAINING

1. The pre-registration training is considered completed only after the following conditions are complied with:
 - a. Completion of the minimum pre-registration training period
 - b. Pass both the Competency Examination and Forensic Exam*
 - c. Achieve the minimum competency standards stated in the SPC Competency Standards Framework
 - d. All other requirements stated for pre-registration training
2. If the pre-registration pharmacist leaves the employment of the certified training centre he/she applies for his/her pre-registration training, his/her pre-registration training will be terminated.
3. In the event he/she wishes to resume his/her pre-registration, he/she has to re-submit a fresh application and documents again, if applicable, and start the pre-registration training all over again.

* The maximum number of attempts allowed for the Competency Exam and Forensic Exam is 3 attempts within 2 years from the first attempt.

B. CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

1. If the conditionally registered pharmacist leaves the employment of the training centre, the following will be cancelled:
 - a. Conditional registration
 - b. Practising certificate
2. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration within 2 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she needs to complete the balance of the duration of conditional registration.
 - b. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.
3. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration after 2 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she will have to re-start the full duration of 1 year / 2 years* conditional registration.
 - b. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.

4. If the pharmacist resumes conditional registration after 5 years from the date of disruption:
 - a. He/she will have to sit and pass the Competency Exam and Forensic Exam first.
 - b. Exam fees apply
 - c. If both exams are cleared, he/she can apply to re-start the full duration of 1 year / 2 years* conditional registration.
 - d. Conditional registration fees and application fees for practising certificate apply.
