To: Employers and Dentists under Conditional Registration

CONDITIONS FOR DENTISTS UNDER CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

A briefing was held on 13 Oct 2015 for clinics employing dentists under Conditional Registration.

Employers were informed of the terms and condition governing Conditional Registration and issues related to the supervision of conditional registrants.

Council has mandated that as of 1 Nov 2015, conditional registrant(s) (including those who are in group practices) can only work in a maximum of two practice addresses.

Dentists under Conditional Registration <u>must work in the approved clinic and be supervised by an approved Division I dentist at all times</u>.

If employers are found to have flouted these conditions, they may be barred from employing Conditional registered dentists in future.

Several reminders have been sent to dental professionals requesting any changes in residential or practice address to be updated online via the PRS within 28 days thereof. Your prompt updates are essential as it will facilitate the pairing of your supervisors and Conditional Registered dentists.

Your attention is drawn to sections 13(4)¹ and (7)² in the Dental Registration Act which states that any person who is found to be guilty, shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

¹ Section 13(4) Every person whose name is entered in any of the registers shall inform the Registrar in writing of any change in his practice address or residential address within 28 days thereof, except that a person who makes a report of a change in his residential address under section 8 of the National Registration Act (Cap. 201) shall be deemed to have complied with this subsection on the date on which he makes the report.

² Section 13(7) Any person who fails to comply with subsection (4) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000
