## Amendments to the Dental Registration Act (DRA)

The Dental Registration (Amendment) Bill was passed on 2 August 2021. The amendments aim to ensure that the quality and competencies of foreign-trained dental graduates who are eligible to register and practise in Singapore remain high to meet the dental care needs of our Singaporeans. Find out how these changes would affect dental students (in-flight and prospective) and experienced dentists.

### Key Changes for Foreign-trained Dental Graduates


### **Current DRA**

- Must be employed with local dental clinic / healthcare institution
- No need to sit for Qualifying Examination
- (QE) Must meet prevailing requirements

### **Amended DRA** on 1 Jan 2029

- Automatically eligible to sit for QE
- Must pass QE
- Must meet prevailing requirements

#### Qualification not listed in DRA Schedule



- Require approval to sit for QE
- Assessed if he/she has the skills, knowledge and experience to practise
- Require approval to sit for QE
  - Must pass QE
  - Must meet prevailing requirements

### Come 1 Jan 2029, what would the changes mean for...



Prospective dental students who graduate on or after 1 Jan 2029

- Meet prevailing requirements for C-reg Qualifications listed in DRA Schedule:
- Foreign-trained Singapore Citizens (SC) and
  - Permanent Residents (PR):
    - No limit to number of attempts for QE
  - All other foreign-trained dentists: Cap of 2 attempts to pass each part of QE
  - Qualifications not listed in DRA Schedule:
  - Must apply for Council's approval to sit for QE


