- Provide a summary of the date(s), name and location(s) of the TCM clinic.

2. Details of the complaint

- Description of the incident;
- State the grounds of your complaint clearly. Provide a header for each allegation made against the TCM practitioner, followed by details.

(b) Making wrong diagnosis

3. Police report/Legal proceeding, if applicable

You should provide us the Police's and Court's reference number and attached a copy of these documents, if any.

4. Provide a list of supporting documents enclosed with the complaint and label them accordingly
