PRESS RELEASE

Registered TCM Practitioner Fined and Censured

1 **Lim Khiam Khoon (林鍼坤)**, of Qian Jin Zhui Chinese Physician Recuperate Centre (千斤坠中医保健学院) (formerly known as Sin tat Chinese Physician Recuperate Centre) at 282A Changi Road, Singapore 400313, a registered TCM physician and registered acupuncturist, was found guilty of contravening Section 19(1)(i) of the TCM Practitioners Act (Cap 333A) (the “**Act**”) for professional misconduct in that he allowed nude photographs of himself to be published in the media.

2 Lim Khiam Khoon was fined \$500 and censured. He was reminded to abstain from any such similar conduct in the future.

4 In addition, pursuant to Section 20(1) of the Act, Lim Khiam Khoon was ordered to pay costs and expenses of or incidental to the inquiry conducted by the Investigation Committee and any action taken by the Board, including expenses of the Board’s solicitors and the legal assessor.
