TCM Practitioners Board Notice 2009/4

Notification on Changes of Personal Name, Residential Status, Place of Practice, Practice Address, Residential Address and Contact Numbers

To: All Registered TCM Practitioners

You have been notified of the provisions in Sections 12(3), (4) & (5) of the **Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners Act (Cap 333A)** in Notice 2004/2 dated 6 May 2004 and Notice 2007/2 dated 1 Jun 2007.

2 All registered TCM practitioners, whether practising full time, part time or as volunteers, are hereby reminded that you must notify the Registrar in writing on any of the following changes within 28 days of the changes:

- a) change in name (according to name(s) as reflected in your NRIC)
- b) change in residential status (eg, change to Singapore Permanent Resident, Singapore Citizen etc)
- c) change in place of work (change of practice place, change of name of practice place, change of address of practice place etc for both principal practice place and other practice place/s);
- d) change in residential address (if the change of residential address is not reported in accordance to Section 8 of the National Registration Act (Cap 201);
- e) change in contact numbers (telephone, fax, handphone numbers etc)

Registered practitioners who have stopped practice, either temporarily or for good, must also notify the Registrar in writing on the change of practice status within 28 days.

Newly registered practitioners, with no practice place at the time of registration, must report the practice place within 28 days of the start of practice, with details on practice place name, practice place address, practice status (part-time or full-time), practice place contact numbers etc.

Any person who fails to comply with the above shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

3 Further, under the provisions of Regulations (2)(1)(a) and (2)(2) of the **Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Composition of Offence) Regulations**, you are also reminded that the Board may compound an offence under Section 12(4) of the TCM Practitioners Act by collecting from the person committed the offence a sum of money not exceeding \$500.

中医管理委员会通告 2009/4

呈报更改个人姓名、居民身份、执业地点、执业地址、
住家地址、联络号码

致：所有注册中医执业者

中医管理委员会（简称“管委会”）曾在2004年5月6日及2007年6月1日寄上通告2004/2及2007/2，通知所有注册者在中医注册法令（Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners Act）第12(3)、(4)及(5)条款下，必须呈报更改个人资料的事项。

2 管委会在此再次提醒所有注册中医执业者（不论是全职、兼职、或义务执业），如有任何下列的更改，必须在更改后的28天内以书面形式向注册官呈报：

- (a) 更改个人姓名（以居民证上的姓名为准）；
- (b) 更改居民身份（如改为新加坡永久居民、新加坡公民等）
- (c) 更改执业地点（如更改执业地点、更改执业地点名称、更改执业地点地址等，包括主要执业地点及其他执业地点）；
- (d) 更改住家地址（如果没有在国家注册法令第8条款下呈报的话）；
- (e) 更改联络号码（电话、传真、手机号码等）

暂时或永久停止执业的注册者也必须在更改执业状况后的28天内以书面形式向注册官呈报。

新注册者在注册时没呈报执业地点，必须在开始执业的28天内以书面形式呈报有关执业地点详情，包括执业地点名称、执业地点地址、执业性质（全职/兼职）及执业地点联络号码等。

任何人不遵守上列条款呈报/更新资料将会面对提控罚款，每项罚款不超过\$1,000。

3 另者，在中医执业者(罚款销案)条例 (Traditional Chinese Medicine Practitioners (Composition of Offence) Regulations) 下，管委会也提醒所有注册中医执业者管委会 有权以“罚款销案”的方式向触犯者征收罚款，每项罚款不超过\$500。
