Terms of Reference

1. To review the Ethical Code and Ethical Guidelines (ECEG) and Handbook on Medical Ethics (HME), taking into consideration:
 - a. The recommendations of the MOH-appointed Workgroup to Review the Taking of Informed Consent and the SMC Disciplinary Process to revise the ECEG provisions on informed consent down to basic irreducible principles, as well as to revise the ECEG as a whole to provide more effective guidance to medical practitioners; and
 - b. Emerging areas of ethical concern and other relevant developments relating to modern medical practice in Singapore and in the world.

2. To recommend updated editions of the ECEG and HME for the SMC's consideration, to serve as a guide to all medical practitioners in their discharge of their professional duties and responsibilities in the context of practice in Singapore.
