General Criteria for Certificate of Competence ("COC") Course Accreditation

- (a) The course has/had to be conducted by a professional body or reputable organisation;
- (b) The course instructor must be reputable and have adequate experience;
- (c) The curriculum of these courses would include basic principles, clinical applications and therapeutic guidelines / treatment guidelines or protocols, complications of procedures and the management of complications;
- (d) Learning to be in the form of hands-on or video learning;
- (e) There should be an examination (e.g. in the form of Multiple Choice Questions) which should be passed prior to the issuance of the certificate; and
- (f) A certificate should be conferred upon passing the examination.
