

Pharmacist Preceptors' Training Programme (Foundational)

The Pharmacist Preceptors' Training Programme aims to promote the development of foundational teaching skills for pharmacist preceptors. The modules are constructed around themes that support individual participant's learning in their specific teaching context.

This 1-day Foundational Programme, offered by the National Healthcare Group (NHG), is accredited by the Singapore Pharmacy Council (SPC) for meeting the training requirements to be a Preceptor for Pre-Registration Pharmacists.

Learning Outcomes

1. Outline the Competency Standards and Code of Ethics set out by the SPC.
2. Describe the critical values and skills expected of a preceptor.
3. Determine the applicable supervisory level and preceptor role for helping a preceptee to progress at his/her stage of learning.
4. Identify and address the preceptee's motivations for learning.
5. Discuss how learning styles impact curriculum design to enhance learning.
6. Outline the principles of effective feedback, on-to-one teaching, and coaching.
7. Outline the SPC requirements for evidence-based and criteria-based documentation of Pre-Registration Pharmacist evaluation.
