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1. Health Products (Cosmetic Products – ASEAN Cosmetic Directive) Regulations 2007 : the Third Schedule (page nos. 16 – 199) listing various prohibited and restricted substances and permitted additives, can be omitted from the hardcopy compilation to be printed for use as reference material for the forensic examination.
 2. Health Products (Therapeutic Products) Regulations 2016 : the Second Schedule (page nos. 68 – 136) listing various active ingredients in prescription-only medicines and pharmacy-only medicines, can be omitted from the hardcopy compilation to be printed for use as reference material for the forensic examination.
 3. Poisons Act (Cap 234) : the Schedule (page nos. 17 – 82) listing the substances scheduled as poisons, can be omitted from the hardcopy compilation to be printed for use as reference material for the forensic examination.
 4. Poisons Rules (Cap 234 R 1) : the First to Tenth Schedules (page nos. 22 – 166) listing various substances subject to special requirements or exemptions, can be omitted from the hardcopy compilation to be printed for use as reference material for the forensic examination.
 5. Misuse of Drugs Act (Cap 185) : the First to Fifth Schedules (page nos. 78 – 143) listing the substances scheduled as controlled drugs, penalty tables and various controlled equipment and materials, can be omitted from the hardcopy compilation to be printed for use as reference for the forensic examination.
