Process for Certification as APN

Educational Requirement

- Clinically focused Master level nursing (MN) programme comprising of at least 500 hours of supervised clinical practicum
- Advanced practice-oriented modules including:
 - Advanced Health/Physical Assessment
 - Advanced Physiology & Pathophysiology
 - Advanced Pharmacology
- Passed MN OSCE

Apply

- Within one year of conferment of MN degree
- Define area of clinical practice & have a named clinical supervisor
- Apply online and upload the following documents:
 - Identification document (NRIC/ Passport)
 - Academic certificates & transcripts
 - SNB's Curriculum Vitae Form
 - SNB's Proposed APN Scope Form
- Request for verification of original transcripts of nursing education from nursing universities & verification of Registration (if applicable)
- Pay applicable fees (for APN certification fee & Preg PC fee)

- One year of supervised clinical practice to allow consolidation of knowledge, skills and practice expected of an APN
- Key Features include
 - Minimum <u>1280 hours</u>. Clinical hours in direct patient care at advanced level
 - Approved clinical areas in the specialty area concerned that allows for complete spectrum of practice in that specialty
 - <u>Named Clinical Supervisor</u> who should be a medical specialist (or an expert APN)
 - <u>Clinical Portfolio</u> as per determined by the MOH APN Internship Committee

Requirement at end of internship

- Submit the following documents to SNB:
 - Verification of supervised clinical practice and core competencies from Clinical Supervisor
 - Recommendations from Clinical Head-of-Department and Chief Nurse/ Director of Nursing
 - Verification of Completion of Internship Form

Outcome

 Grant full certification after successful completion of internship and endorsed by Institution CAC & Cluster CAC
