REDUCTION OF SUPERVISION PERIOD FOR FOREIGN ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS ON CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION

The Allied Health Professions Council (AHPC) has reviewed the supervision period for foreign allied health professionals (AHPs) on conditional registration (C-Reg).

2 Under the AHPC's Supervisory Framework, all newly registered AHPs on C-Reg will undergo a period of supervision ranging from 12 months to 24 months. Currently, foreign AHPs are required to undergo 24 months of supervision. After analysing the trends and feedback over the past few years, the AHPC is reducing the supervision period of foreign C-Regs.

3 With effect from 1 October 2023, all new foreign applicants who are granted C-Reg will only need to undergo 18 months of supervision. Existing foreign C-Reg AHPs who are required to undergo 24 months of supervision will be eligible to progress to Full Registration upon satisfactory completion of 18 months of supervision. Supervisors may submit the Supervisor Assessment Reports (SARs) ie. Forms SF3, SF4 and SF6 for these C-Regs to AHPC for review, at the end of their 17th month of supervised practice.

4 There will be no change to the period of supervision for C-Reg AHPs who are working part-time and/or graduated with a Graduate Entry Masters (GEM) qualification. They are still required to undergo 36 and 24 months of supervision respectively.
