## **APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION WITH THE ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL FOR NYP GRADUATES**

We refer to our circular 1401-C01 dated 17 January 2014 regarding NYP graduates' application for registration.

2 The AHPC have received feedback that some of you and/or your employers would like you to be able to start work as soon as possible, and asked if the registration outcome could be received earlier as this would also impact on the recognition of the period of supervised practice completed prior to your degree-conversion programmes.

### **Registration Application**

3 If you wish to start work shortly after your results are released, you are advised to submit your application for registration (RR1) immediately. If your application form is complete with all its required supporting documents as outlined in the circular 1401-C01, and your employer is able to meet the supervision requirements, we will inform you of your registration outcome via email within 2 working days of the release of your results and complete your practising certificate application process.

4 However, if clarifications of your registration application are required (e.g. regarding the suitability of your supervisors or other issues affecting your registration), there will be delays in the processing of your application.

### **Practising Certificate Application**

5 You may also wish to submit an application for your practising certificate (RR5 without fees) at the same time when you submit your registration application. The

fees for your practising certificate should be paid at the time of collection of your registration certificate.
